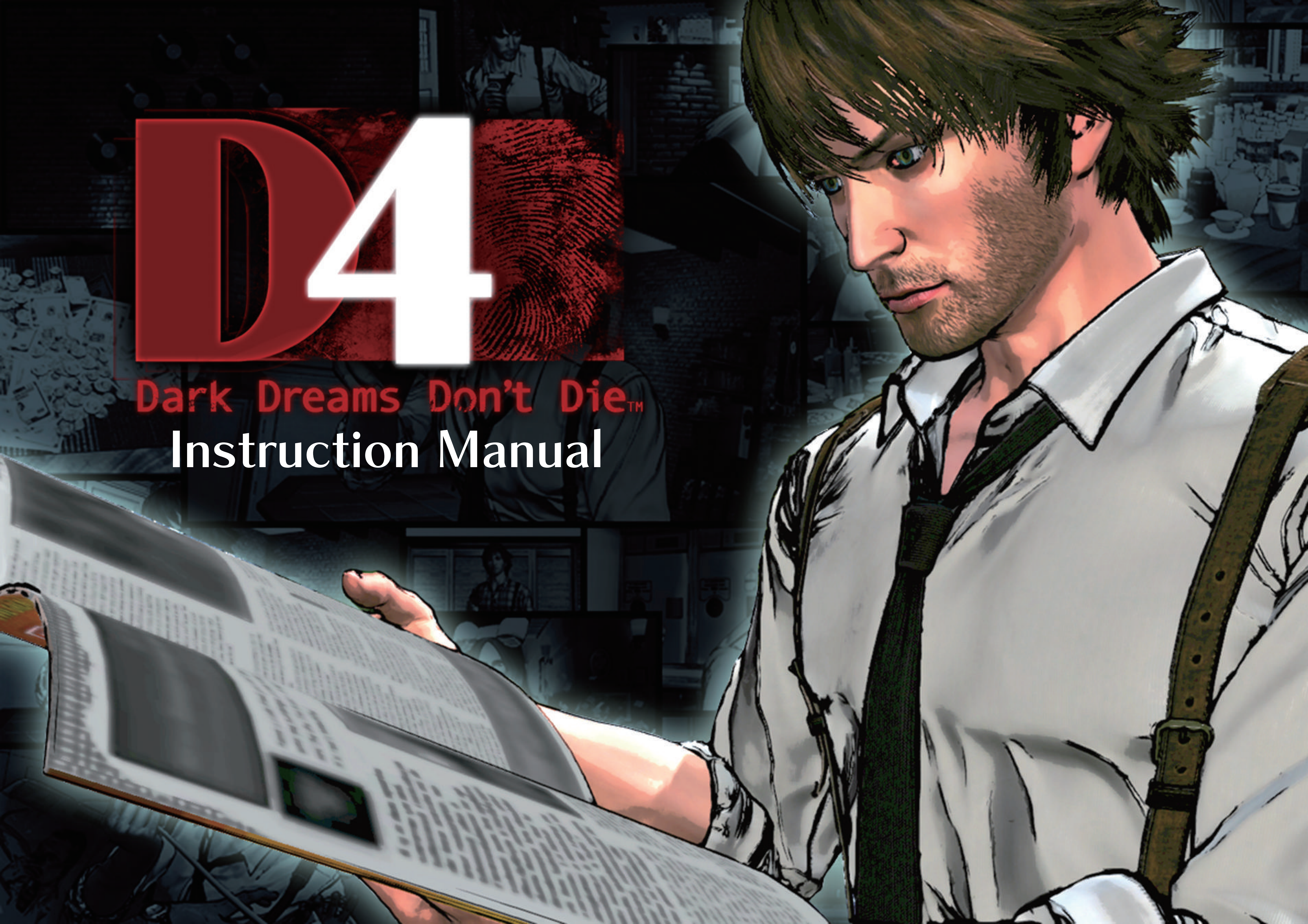

How to Start the Game

Please directly launch the game from D4.exe.

Game Settings: Select the settings in the window, then press OK.

The game should then start.

FAQ

Q. Why won't the game start?

A. In order to play this game, certain software is necessary.

Please look at [4. Necessary Runtimes] and download the necessary software.

Q. Why won't the game start in full screen mode?

A. If your IME language bar is floating, the game will be minimized and will not run properly.

Please make sure to attach the IME bar to the taskbar.

Q. Why doesn't the ESC key work?

A. If other applications are open, the ESC key may not work inside the game.

If the ESC key stops working while you're playing the game, please close the other applications.

Q. Why don't the keyboard controls work?

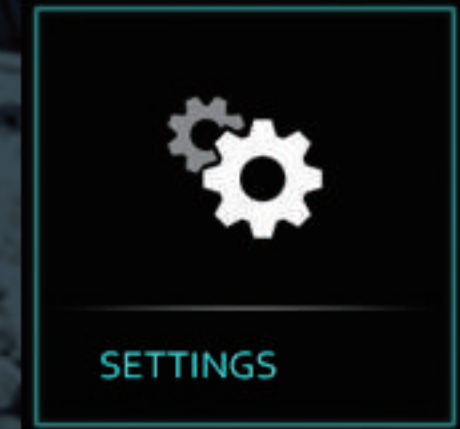
A. If you're using a Japanese keyboard input, and you press the full width/half width button after starting up the game, and make Japanese input active, the keyboard controls will stop working. Please turn Japanese input off.

GAME MENU



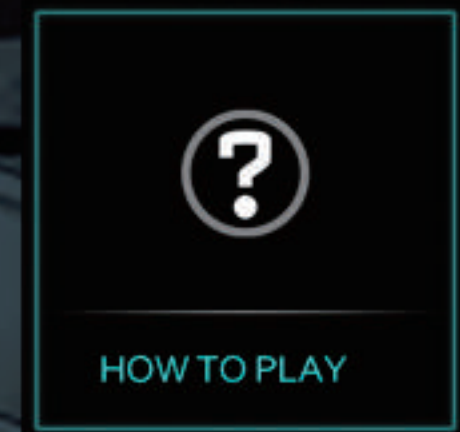
How to open the game menu:
When using mouse and keyboard controls, press the ESC key or move the mouse cursor to the top part of the screen and left click the menu icon.
When using the controller, press the start button.
This will allow you to access the investigation files, settings, control options, and title screen..

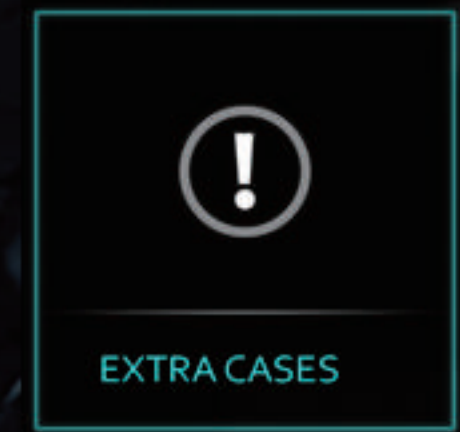
You can find this under the control options.

INVESTIGATION



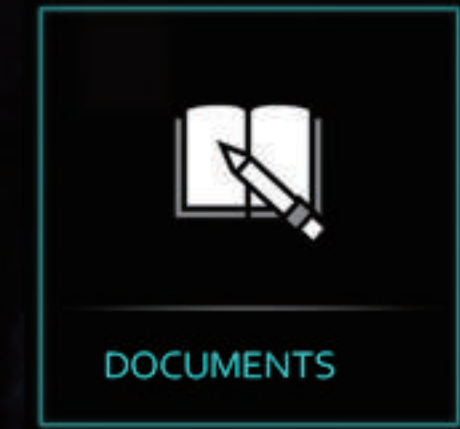
From the Investigation files, you can access the Extra Cases, Documents, Food List, Mementos, and Characters.

EXTRA CASES



In Extra Cases, you can check on the extra cases that have appeared during your investigation, or look for hints from past cases.
In order to check on a case, select a character from the list, then select the case file you want to read.

DOCUMENTS



The Documents allow you to look at all the information you've collected.

FOOD LIST



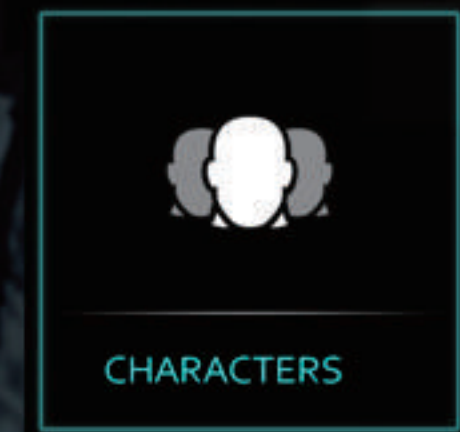
The Food List allows you to look at all the food you've collected.

MEMENTOS



In Mementos, you can look at all the mementos that David's used to dive into the past.
From the high heel to the marshal's badge, you can look at what makes a memento, and what sort of pasts are hidden within them.

CHARACTERS








Use the Characters list to guess who the culprit is.

HOW TO PLAY

The game can be played using either a controller or a mouse and keyboard. You can also seamlessly switch between the two control schemes.

His wife's dying words, "Look for D," keep resonating in his heart as he searches for a case that will connect him to "D."



Olivia Jones

A flight attendant on Flight AG117.

She looks just like David's dead wife, but that isn't the only reason she sticks out to him...



Peggy Young / Little Peggy

David Young's wife, whom David always called Little Peggy. Two years ago, someone murdered her in their bathroom.



Philip Cheney

A flight attendant on AG Flight 117.

At first glance, he appears to be handsome and gentlemanly, but sometimes he seems a bit... unstable.

Amanda

A mysterious girl who appeared in Young's apartment one day. She moves like a cat. Sometimes she brings home food, so David decided to keep her.



Antonio 'Rabbit' Zapatero

A drug courier who dealt with a drug known as 'Real Blood.' He made a plea bargain in exchange for evidence related to "D," the source of the drug.



Forrest Kaysen

David's old partner, and currently a member of the BPD Narcotics Unit.

After David lost his wife and his old self, Kaysen was the one who supported him.

Kaysen used to be strong detective known as the 'Grizzly,' but he's lost all trace of that now, so people call him 'Teddy' instead.

Sometimes, he brings information to help David in his investigation of his wife's death.



Derek Buchanan

The marshal in charge of escorting the Real Blood courier. He's been working with the DEA, and is also a potential "D."

Duncan & Sukey

A fashion designer who's riding as a passenger on Flight AG117. He claims to work together on all his designs with his partner 'Sukey,' and demands that people respect her as much as him, even though Sukey seems to be nothing more than a mannequin...



Roland Walken

A mysterious man who David always meets whenever he dives into the past.

He wears a white suit and looks clean-cut, but holds a knife and fork in his hands and says very mysterious things.



Deborah Anderson

A passenger on Flight AG117, and a potential "D." She works as a nurse in Boston, and is going on a vacation to Washington D.C. in order to celebrate her fifth year of employment. She always carries a notepad where she documents things she considers to be strange or dangerous.



David's Apartment

In the world of D4, David's apartment is his home base.

When he returns to his apartment, he can communicate with other characters, check his files, change characters' outfits, watch TV, and listen to records. By selecting "End Dive" from the Game Menu, you can return to David's apartment at any time.

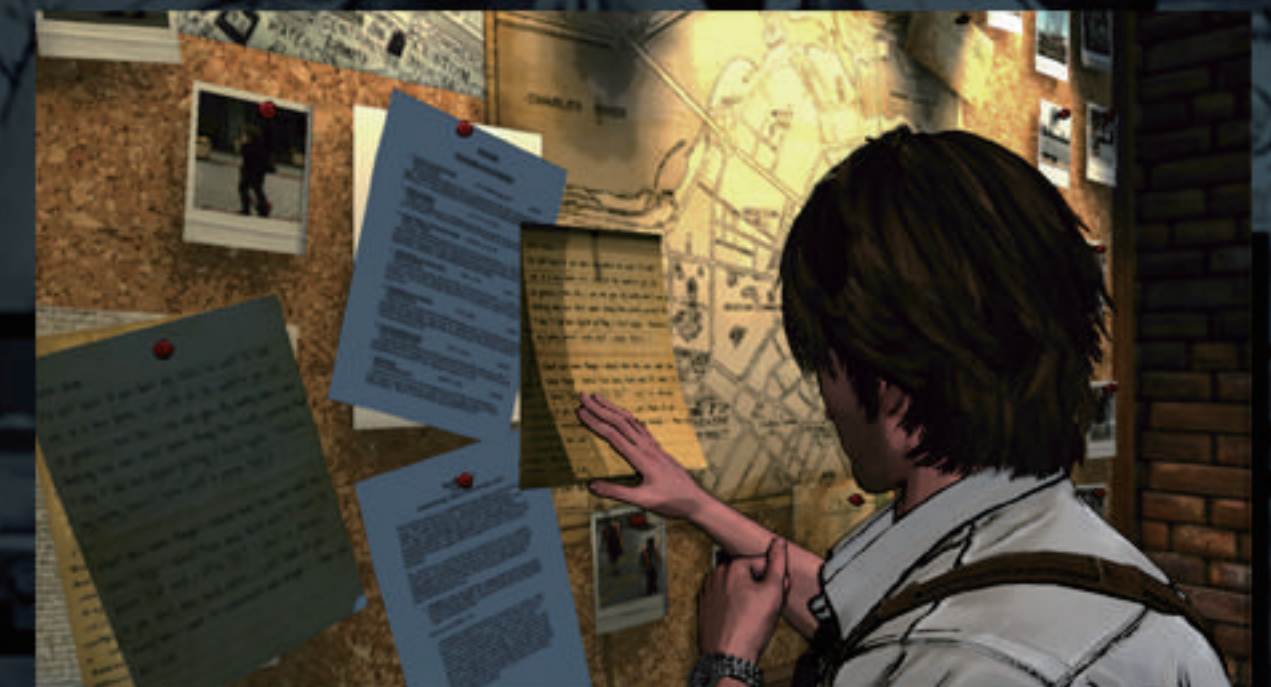
Characters

David's Apartment

Closet

Open the closet in the bedroom to access costumes for various characters. Here you can select a new outfit or mix and match to create your own.



TV and Music

In the living room, you can change the background music with the record player or watch TV. Be sure to check out what's on TV.



Using Mementos

Mementos are items that have been left behind by someone, but still contain important memories within them. David can use these to dive back into the past and investigate events that have already happened. In order to use a memento and dive, David has to go into the bathroom and make the dive gesture. You can also select "Dive" from the Game Menu.

LIFE / STAMINA / VISION

LIFE



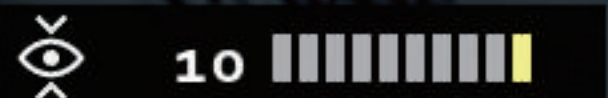
When you take damage, you lose life. Be sure to use medical items that are hidden throughout the different scenes to heal yourself.

STAMINA



Whenever you do a special action, you lose stamina. If you lose all your stamina, David will collapse. You can eat food to regain stamina.

VISION



Use Vision to look at a certain scene from a different angle. Vision will highlight special items or hints that can be investigated, allowing you to pinpoint your search on specific things that are directly connected to the case. Vision can be restored by drinking things.
